

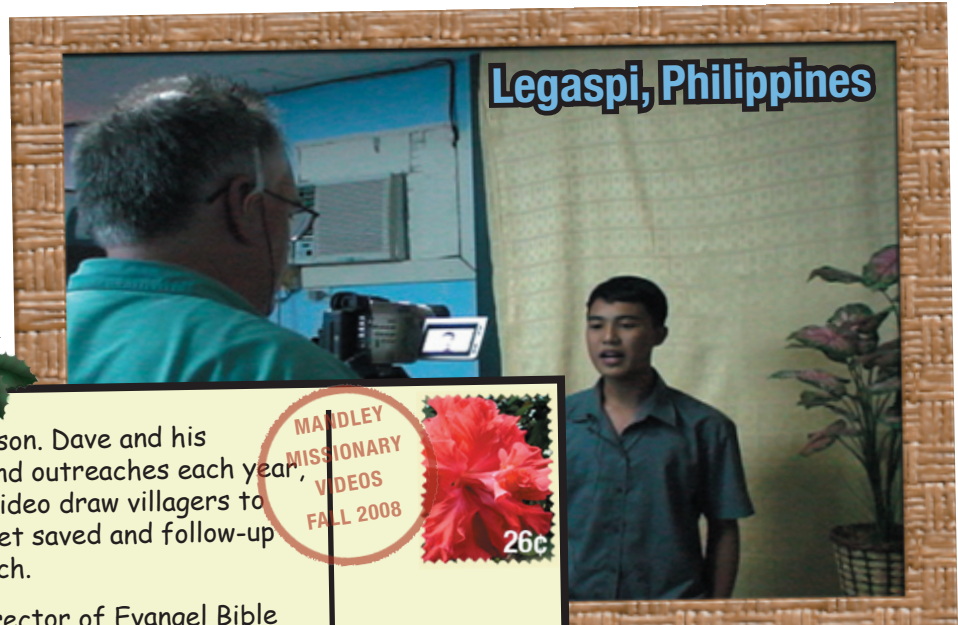

Legaspi, Philippines

Greetings from Legaspi,
We were with Dave and Debbie Johnson. Dave and his evangelist team hold 45 to 50 weekend outreaches each year, usually in rural villages. Music and a video draw villagers to a presentation of the Gospel. Many get saved and follow-up discipleship is done with each outreach.

Debbie is finishing up her term as director of Evangel Bible College. We videotaped students in worship, classrooms, and presenting a drama.

While Mac finished editing the Johnson's video Barb got to teach a parenting seminar and developed a small parenting Bible study as a resource for Debbie & her students.

Our biggest hassle involved our newest camera, it quit working. Praise God, we had a 3rd camera with us. The Johnsons paid for the camera repair in Legaspi then had their staff take it to the AG office in Manila. We retrieved it as we traveled between missionaries 2 and 3.

Mindoro, our last stop before we headed home, Ray & Deborah Miller are the first and only A/G missionaries on Mindoro Island, an island about 1/2 the size of Massachusetts with over 1.1 million people. The Lord gave us a glorious sunset on the ferry there.

The Millers train & develop pastors and churches all over the island through counseling, preaching, music and puppets. We videotaped everything from a city outreach, to services in a tribal mountain village. The village had an amazing view of the ocean. After 1 village service Barb helped Deborah with a "Boo-boo & Cut Clinic". They cleaned out the children's insect bits & minor infections. This provided a view into a world most in the USA have not seen. Infections start very quickly in the jungle.

The videos turned out well! We LOVE the privilege of serving God, ministering to our Assemblies of God missionaries on your behalf, and seeing what God is doing around the world.

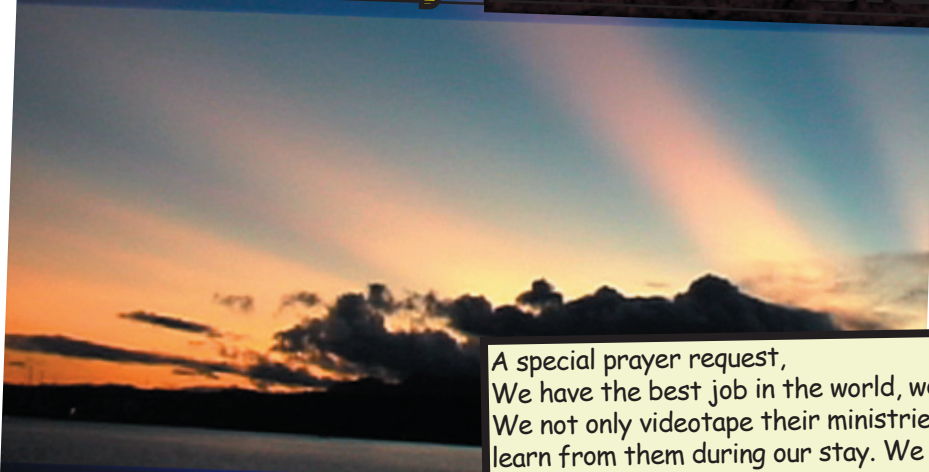
Sunrise on the Ferry
