A/G pastor Rony Jordan is a general contractor whose ministry, *Shelters of Hope*, refurbishes Israeli bomb shelters near the Lebanese border. He affixes a plaque in the shelter naming the church

that funded the project. This ministry shows God’s love in a tangible way to the apartment families.

Usually we live with missionaries as we produce their DVD. But this trip Rony’s wife and son were able to join him at the last minute. So there was not room for us in his apartment. Two weeks before we arrived Rony met Susan Heagy, president of AHI, *Abundant Hope International*. Rony arranged for us to stay at *Beit Shalom*, AHI’s Christian guesthouse.

For several months AHI’s leaders prayed for a promotional DVD. Weeks before we arrived God awoke Susan to have her outline the topics to include in a DVD. When we arrived the staff said we were an answer to prayer. We definitely felt God was guiding our time in Israel!
