A Recent Surprise

God surprised us with an unexpected project. On a Wednesday in the middle of February, we received an e-mail from friends serving as missionaries to Japan for the past 30 years. We have talked to them on a few occasions about producing a video, but the timing had not worked out. The e-mail told us they were itinerating in southern California and needed a video. They asked if we would be in southern California in the next couple of weeks.

Japan is the second largest unreached people group in the world.

We were in the middle of a project for Africa, but it did not have an immediate deadline. So we could either make an opening the following week or wait for the next opening, which was not until the second half of March. Instead of going to southern California, we asked if they could stay with us in Arizona while we worked their video. They arrived that Sunday evening. When they left on Saturday, they had a short and a long version of their video for their next iteration service that Sunday.

Snider's ministry includes helping victims still recovering from the 2011 tsunami that hit Japan's northeast coast. Japan is the second largest unreached people group in the world. The area hit by the tsunami is one of the hardest areas of Japan for presenting the gospel. Since the tsunami, Japanese A/G churches from neighboring areas have brought in aid and support.

Africa

The Lemons have trained over 100 national church leaders through the West Africa Advanced School of Theology (WAAST). Jim is also the Regional Director for Global University in Central and West Africa, supervising Global's activities for several thousand students in over 20 countries. He also works with Pan-Africa Theological Seminary (PATHS) where as Francophone Coordinator he is facilitating the development of the first ever PhD theological degree in French with a Pentecostal emphasis. The Lemons were asked to move from Cameroon to Togo to enable them to work more closely with WAAST and PATHS. They asked us to update the video we made in 2013 to reflect this move.
